Husky's Community Rebate Program – Terms and Conditions (as of July 2008)

ELIGIBILITY

Application for the Community Rebate Program is open to community-based non-profit groups (including registered charities and public sector bodies) that have an established structure allowing for the authority to participate in such a Program and to receive funds on behalf of the group. It must be indisputable to all members that the funds raised are properly accounted for to the members of that group. Examples of participating groups include but are not limited to clubs, community associations, cultural groups, sports groups. Husky reserves the right to determine eligibility and re-evaluate group eligibility at any point in the relationship through this Program. Husky's decision is final.

PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM

To initiate participation, an approved group representative must complete a Program application form. Upon approval, Husky will provide the appropriate quantity of plastic magnetic stripe cards to be used by group members. The cards are not personalized by member name, only by number. It is the responsibility of the group administrator to record card numbers and members' names.

ACCUMULATION OF REBATES

Group members must present their Husky Community Rebate card at the time of purchase to earn Community Rebates. Eligible purchases include fuel, lubricants, service and repairs, automotive parts, groceries and convenience store items and Husky House Restaurant meals. The Community Rebate card is accepted at participating Husky and Mohawk retail locations and HH Restaurants in Canada. The rebates from each individual card transaction accumulate into the group's account. Rebates are calculated at 2% of the retail purchase. The Community Rebate card is not a form of payment for Husky or Mohawk purchases.

INELIGIBLE PURCHASES

Lottery tickets and tobacco product purchases are not eligible for rebates. Husky gas certificates are also ineligible however, rebates will be paid for gas certificates being redeemed. Purchases made with Husky Route Commander Cards, or bulk account payments do not qualify for Rebates. The Community Rebate Program cannot to be used in conjunction with any other loyalty rewards program (ie. CAA Program). Community Rebates will not be credited for the GST amount on single transactions over \$1000 (on repairs, for example).

PAYMENT OF REBATES

Community Rebates will be paid to participating groups quarterly. If the Rebate amount payable is less than \$50, then payment will be rolled over to the next quarter when the rebate amount equals or exceeds \$50.

YOUR PERSONAL PRIVACY

You consent to Husky's collection and use of your personal information and any personal information of individual members of your group provided to Husky for the purposes of administration, operation, promotion and evaluation of the

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Neither Husky, nor any of our Retailers have any responsibility or liability for any expense, loss, cost, or any other matter or thing whatsoever, however suffered or caused (including compensatory, incidental, indirect, special, punitive, consequential or exemplary damages), directly or indirectly arising out of or related to (i) the Program or your participation in the Program; (ii) any failure, delay or decision by us in administering the Program or amending these terms and conditions or the basis on which you can earn Community Rebates; (iii) any offer, representation, statement or claim about the Program.

TERMINATION, CHANGES AND BREACH

Husky may change these terms and conditions and/or any aspect of this Program (including termination) without notice. For example but without limitation, we may add, delete or change eligible purchases, accumulation or redemption details regarding Community Rebates (ie. the percentage calculation). If your group becomes bankrupt, commits fraud, misrepresents any information, violates any terms and conditions, abuses the Program privileges or acts in any other way to the detriment of Husky or our Retailers, we may, without affecting our other rights, disclose such information requested by proper authorities, terminate your participation in the Program and/or cancel your earned rebates.

GENERAL

The Husky Community Rebate Program is owned and operated by Husky Energy Inc. These terms and conditions constitute the entire agreement between your group and Husky regarding your participation in accumulating and receiving Community Rebates. Except as expressly contained in these terms and conditions, there are no conditions, representations, and warranties, express or implied, statutory or otherwise. Husky is the final authority as to the interpretation of these terms and conditions and as to any other questions or disputes regarding the Program. All materials and any notices from us will be sent to your address as recorded in our membership account system; please notify Husky if your address changes. If any provision of these terms and conditions is invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remaining terms and conditions.
